



- Right to privacy: Protects personal information from being used without permission.  
Example: Personal details used only for account creation in online games.
- Right to freedom of expression: Allows users to share opinions online respectfully.  
Example: Sharing opinions about a TV show politely.
- Right to safety: Ensures users are protected from cyberbullying and harmful behaviour.  
Example: Reporting online bullying to a trusted adult.
